A \$100.00 ADMINISTRATION FEE WILL BE RETAINED ON ALL NOTIFIED CANCELLATION MADE WITHIN 2 WEEKS OF RENTAL DATE. NO-SHOWS OR CANCELLATION MADE LESS THAN 2 DAYS (48 HOURS) OF RESERVATION DATED WILL BE CHARGED THE ENTIRE RENTAL AMOUNT. THERE WILL BE NO REFUND GIVEN IF THE RENTER CANCELS AT ANY TIME WITHIN THE RESERVED PERIOD. I UNDERSTAND THAT JOURNEYS OF SGI CANNOT CONTROL THE WEATHER AND I WILL NOT BE GIVEN A REFUND DUE TO WEATHER CONDITIONS. I ALSO UNDERSTAND THAT THE DAMAGE DEPOSIT WILL BE CANCELLED AFTER THE BOAT HAS BEEN THOROUGHLY INSPECTED AND CAN BE UP TO 24 HOURS.

BOAT RENTAL POLICY

Renter must take full responsibility for rental property and all inherent risks. Renter and all renters' guest must have personal floatation devices, which are included on boat. Report any boating accident to the Florida Marine Patrol by calling 911 and/or radio for help on the VHF channel 16. LIABILITY RELEASE – WAIVER

RENTER AND ALL GUESTS HEREBY AGREE TO HOLD RENTOR, THEIR AGENTS, SUCCESSORS AND ASSGNS, THEIR INSURANCE COMPANY, JOURNEYS OF SGI HARMLESS FOR ANY LOSS, INJURY OR DAMAGE TO PERSON OR PROPERTY OCCURRING AS A RESULT OF THE USE OF BOAT AND/OR EQUIPMENT BY RENTER OR RENTER'S GUESTS AND AGREES TO INDEMNIFY RENTOR AND THEIR RESPECTIVE AGENTS, SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, AGAINST ANY CLAIMS OF DAMAGE, INJURY OR LIABILITY TO ANY PROPERTY OR PERSON(S) WHAT-SO-EVER, OCCURRING AS A RESULT OF THE USE OF BOAT AND/OR EQUIPMENT BY RENTER OR RENTER'S GUESTS. JOURNEYS OF SGI RENTALS ASSUMES NO LIABILITY FOR THIS RENTAL OR ITS CONSEQUENCES.

FURTHER AGREED

On expiration or earlier termination of this lease, renter shall return Boat and/or equipment to owner by delivering it to the rentor where it was accepted in good repair; any damage will be charged to renter and is due on demand. This agreement is a demise charter and rentor maintains no control over renter's use of the boat. Therefore, renter agrees to indemnify and hold rentor harmless of, from and against any loss, costs, damages, attorney's fees and/or liability in connection with the enforcement of this agreement, and including expenses incurred in collecting or attempting to collect rentals in the event of suit by rentor to recover possession of the rented property and/or to enforce any of the terms, conditions and/or provisions hereof. I understand that all agree to the terms and conditions of the rental policies set forth above and on the other page of this agreement.

ALL RENTERS AND OPERATORS OF BOATS MUST BE AT LEAST 25 YEARS OLD AND OBEY ALL FLORIDA AND UNITED STATES LAWS.

BOAT WILL BE OPERATED IN APALACHICOLA BAY AND RIVER **ONLY**.
